

PIANO

The piano must be tuned before the sound check. Piano bench must be solid and have adjustable height.

BASS

- 1 bassamp
- 1 orchestral music stand
- -> Bassplayer brings own doublebass

DRUMS

Jazzkit (Gretsch, Yamaha, Ludwig, Slingerland..) all equipped with Remo Ambassador Coated skins.

- 18" bass drum
- 12" tom tom
- 14" floor tom
- 14" snare drum
- 3 cymbalstands
- drum rug, drum chair, bass drumpedal, snarestand, tom mount and hihat stand with clutch
- 1 orchestral music stand
- -> Drummer brings own cymbals and sticks

STRINGS

- 4 orchestral music stands
- 4 chairs
- ->Stringplayers bring their own close mics (dpa clip condenser, or Schertler Dyn)

MONITORING (according to size of venue)

5 monitor wedges with independent mixes, volume and EQ for each instrument.

PA (according to size of venue)

Professional, at least two-way active system. The PA has to be configured in STEREO. The choice, size and setup of the PA system has to guarantee even coverage, a linear frequency response and sufficient dynamic response (110dB) over the whole audience area.
